Well, 2021 turned out to be an excellent year for the stock market believe it or not. For the year the (S&P 500) was up approximately +26.89% on a price basis and +28.71% on a total return basis (includes reinvested dividends). The market was driven higher to a large extent by the so- called mega cap stocks but was fairly broad based. International stocks lagged the S&P 500 and Bonds in general were flat to lower but remember we use them as a diversification tool.

Overall, it was another good year for investors in the face of uncertainty. As I have stated ad nauseum, a correction of 10+% in the stock market is normal and even a healthy occurrence. We should expect them and stick to our investment plans realizing they are a normal part of investing. I will repeat one of my favorite quotes below from the famed money manager Peter Lynch.
